RESOLUTION NO. 12-2021

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the federal government through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) created the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (CSLFRL) to help local communities during and after the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Marblehead has qualified for and will receive Local Fiscal Recovery funds to offset the expense caused by the coronavirus pandemic; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to standards established by the Auditor of State, it is necessary to create a Local Fiscal Recovery Fund by Resolution of the legislative authority for the purpose of accounting for the funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the Village of Marblehead, Ottawa County, Ohio:

- **Section 1.** That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to establish fund number 2152 titled Local Fiscal Recovery Fund for the purpose of accounting for funds.
- **Section 2.** That this Resolution and all actions and deliberations of Council and its committees related thereto were conducted in meeting open to the public pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Oho Revised Code.
- **Section 3.** That this Ordinance authorizing the Fiscal Officer to establish the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund is an emergency measure, for the reason that this fund must be established immediately to deposit and account for the relevant money.
