


# Prescription Drug Disposal

The Marblehead Police Department has acquired Detera Drug Disposal Bags thanks to and through the Mental Health and Recovery Board of Seneca, Ottawa, Sandusky, and Wyandot County, they have been able to secure a large number of Detera drug bags. These bags allow individuals to place their unused prescription pills into the bag, put water in the bag, and a short time later, the entire bag can be thrown into their trash. We still will be keeping our drug disposal drop box located in our lobby as well.
